SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

SUNDAY 16TH MAY 2010

1. Burnham-on-Sea Motor Club Ltd & Taunton Motoring Club Ltd will promote a NATIONAL 'B' Hillclimb on Sunday 16th May 2010 at Wiscombe Park, Near Honiton, Devon, EX24 6JE.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA (referred here after as GR), and these Supplementary Regulations (referred here after as SR) and any written instructions the promoting clubs may issue.
3. MSA Permit No. will be advised in Final Instructions.
4. The event is (a round of and) open to Registered Contenders in the **"Bridge Tyres & Wheels" 2010 ASWMC Hillclimb Championship** (MSA Registration No. **CHS2010/075**), the **"Bridge Tyres & Wheels" 2010 Wiscombe Park Hillclimb Championship** (MSA Registration No. TBC), the **Trident Engineering WAMC Sprint & Hillclimb Championship** (MSA Registration No. TBC), **TVR Car Club Speed Championship** (MSA Registration No. TBC), **2010 "Hamilton Classic" ACSMC Speed Hillclimb Championship** (MSA Registration No. **CHS2010/083**) and the **Scimitar & Sabre Speed Championship**, (MSA Registration No. TBA). Also open to Members of the organising clubs, members of the RSSOC, members of **member clubs of the Association of South Western Motor Clubs**, members of **member clubs of the Association of Central Southern Motor Clubs** and members of **member clubs of the Welsh Association of Motor Clubs** holding an MSA, RIAC, or an equivalent status competition licence issued by the ASN of a member country of the EU, valid for the event. Championship Registration Cards, Club Membership Cards and Competition Licences will be inspected at Signing On.
5. The programme for the meeting (where possible) will follow the timetable below:-
 - i) Scrutineering will start at 07:30 am.
 - ii) Practice will start at 08:30 am and finish at 12:30 pm.
 - iii) The first competitive run will be at 1:00 pm.
 - iv) Any competitor not signed on by 09:30 am MAY be excluded.
6. The length of the course is 1000 yards (914 metres) consisting of several fast bends, two sharp left hand corners and one sharp right hand corner.
7. Classes will be as follows:-
 - A1. Roadgoing Series Production Cars up to 1400cc
 - A2. Roadgoing Series Production Cars over 1400cc up to 1800cc
 - A3. Roadgoing Series Production Cars over 1800cc up to 2600cc
 - A4. Roadgoing Series Production Cars over 2600cc
 - B1. Roadgoing Specialist Production Cars, Car Engines up to 1400cc & M/C Engines up to 875cc
 - B2. Roadgoing Specialist Production Cars. Car Engines over 1400cc up to 1800cc & M/C Engines over 875cc up to 1125cc
 - B3. Roadgoing Specialist Production Cars. Car Engines over 1800cc & M/C Engines over 1125cc
 - C1. Modified Limited Production Cars up to 1400cc
 - C2. Modified Limited Production Cars over 1400cc up to 1800cc
 - C3. Modified Limited Production Cars over 1800cc up to 2600cc
 - C4. Modified Limited Production Cars over 2600cc
 - C5. Modified Specialist Production Cars. Car Engines up to 1800cc & M/C Engines up to 1125cc
 - C6. Modified Specialist Production Cars. Car Engines over 1800cc & M/C Engines over 1125cc
 - D1. Sports Libre Cars up to 1800cc
 - D2. Sports Libre Cars over 1800cc
 - D3*. Rally Cars up to 1600cc
 - D4*. Rally Cars over 1600cc
 - E1. Racing Cars up to 1100cc
 - E2. Racing Cars over 1100cc up to 1600cc
 - E3. Racing Cars over 1600cc
 - S1. Scimitar & Sabre Speed Championship Class
 - T1. TVR-A. TVRs with 4 or 6 cylinder engines built before 1st January 1992
 - T2. TVR-B. All other TVRs

All vehicles must comply with Hillclimb & Sprint Technical Regulations GR I.46 to I.132. When completing the Entry Form, drivers are reminded to indicate the event class and championship class (which may be different) for correct points allocation. The onus of responsibility for the eligibility of vehicles competing in championships rests with the entrant/competitor. Where disputes occur relating to vehicle compliance the onus will be on the competitor to satisfy the organisers, NOT the organisers to prove compliance.

* Cars in these classes must comply with current MSA vehicle Technical Regulations for Stage Rallies (GR R 46.1 - 49.10.3). Cars need not be taxed, but must have a current valid MOT certificate. Cars must be presented for scrutineering with a valid MSA Log Book. Tyres marked "For Racing Purposes Only" are prohibited but otherwise tyre choice is free.

8. Awards-
Fastest Time of Day - An Award 1st in each Class - An Award
2nd in each Class - An Award (subject to 6 starters)
3rd in each class - An Award (subject to 8 starters)

No competitor may win more than ONE of these awards. Additional Awards may be added at the discretion of the organisers.

9. The maximum entry is 130 and the minimum is 80. The minimum number for each class is 4, should this figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate the class. No car may be entered in more than one class, or shared by more than two drivers. A driver may drive a maximum of two cars, which MUST be in different classes. Drivers entering two cars should specify which entry has priority.
10. Entries open on publication of these Regulations and **close on Saturday 1st May 2010.**

The entry fee is £70.00

All entries MUST be made on the Official Entry Form, accompanied by the correct fee and 1 Self Addressed Envelope, sent to the Entries Secretary. **Post dated cheques will NOT be accepted, however cheques will not be banked until the Closing Date.** All entries will be acknowledged and will be accepted by notification of Final Instructions, which will be despatched on or before Monday 10th May 2010.

Entry will be accepted on first received basis (until maximum entry), this will also apply to any reserves.

11. Practice will be in class and number order. All competitors will be given the opportunity of two practice runs, which need not be timed. Competitors are strongly advised to walk the hill prior to 08.30, but must ensure their car, helmet and overalls are available to be scrutineered.
12. Drivers of shared cars must ensure that the correct competition number is displayed on each run. Competitors are required to provide their own competition numbers in accordance with GR S 9.2.5 - S 9.2.6. Numbers will not be available to purchase at the venue. The '2nd' driver will generally run in the batch prior to the class in which the car is entered.
13. Times will be displayed throughout the meeting. Provisional results will be announced after the completion of each class (GR D 26.1.1). Protests/Appeals should be made in accordance with GR C 5.1 – 5.4.1 & C 6.1-6.4.
14. Any competitor, unless in any Championship which has specific tyre rules shall comply with the following:
Any radial ply tyre is allowed which is fully road legal and capable of acceptance by an Annual Dept of Transport Vehicle inspection (MOT Test). Tyres marked "Racing Purposes Only" or similar wording are not allowed. Cross Ply tyres are not allowed. There are no maximum tyre sizes. Cars with tyres offered as manufacturers standard or optional fitting, of wider section, of lower aspect ratio, may be eligible. The onus of proving eligibility to use such tyres is the responsibility of the competitor.
15. Cars will start singly in their own time after a green light signal. Method of timing is electrical, by breaking light beams at the start and finish lines. ALL cars must be fitted with a timing strut as specified in GR S 10.9. The Finish will be marked with a Finish banner above the course.
16. Time permitting, drivers will be given at least two timed runs, the best time to count. Should circumstances not permit all of the class to be offered two runs, then only the first run will count.
17. Entry fees will only be refunded if given in writing as follows:-
a) Notification of withdrawal before closing date - Full refund.
b) Notification of withdrawal after closing date and before despatch of Final Instructions. Entry fee less a maximum of £15 administration charge.
18. Competitors using non-pump fuel must indicate this on their entry form and at signing on.
